Apology Regarding the Fatal Employee Accident at the "Flying Balloon" in Tokyo Dome City Attractions

At approximately 11:50 a.m. today, on Tuesday, April 21, 2026, an accident occurred at the amusement ride "Flying Balloon" within Tokyo Dome City Attractions, in which one of our employees was caught in a ride vehicle during regular inspection work. Following rescue operations, the employee was transported to the hospital, where their death was subsequently confirmed.

We sincerely pray for the repose of the soul of the deceased employee, and we extend our deepest condolences and apologies to the bereaved family. Furthermore, we would like to reiterate our apologies to all customers and relevant parties for the inconvenience and concern caused by this accident.

We are making every effort to investigate the cause of the accident in cooperation with relevant authorities, including the police and fire departments. We will promptly report the details as soon as they become known.

Please be advised that the operation of all amusement rides at Tokyo Dome City Attractions will be suspended from today for the time being. We will make every effort to thoroughly investigate the cause and prevent any recurrence.

Our company takes this situation extremely seriously. We deeply apologize once again for the inconvenience this may cause to our customers.
