Turning Tokyo Dome City into a Sacred Ground of Entertainment Tech A members-only co-working space specializing in Web3, XR, and Al, "enXross DAO" is launching in Tokyo Dome City!

Empowering Users Through DAO (Decentralized Autonomous Organization) Innovation and Cultivating a Dynamic Global Network

Tokyo Dome Corporation (Head Office: Bunkyo-ku, Tokyo; Representative Director President and COO: Tsutomu Nagaoka) will open a members-only co-working space called "enXross DAO" on the 4th floor of the MEETS PORT commercial complex in Tokyo Dome City in November 2025, with the aim of strengthening enXross's initiative to establish Tokyo Dome City as a Sacred Ground for entertainment tech.


Targeted primarily at domestic and international startups developing businesses that combine entertainment with emerging technologies such as Web3, XR, and AI, as well as creators, engineers, and developers whose work aligns with the assets of Tokyo Dome City, the space will go beyond a typical workspace. It will adopt a DAO model, allowing users to actively participate in decision-making regarding office operations, networking, and resource sharing.





We plan to offer members of this space an inspiring workspace with sweeping views of Tokyo Dome, along with access to Tokyo Dome City as a real-world testing ground for new ideas. The DAO model will be shaped in partnership with Mike Fraietta, founder of EmpireDAO—a pioneering co-working space in New York City that redefined how Web3 startups connect, build, and govern together. With a proven track record of empowering decentralized communities through in-person collaboration, Fraietta brings a globally recognized playbook for DAO-driven innovation, now adapted to the unique scale and cultural context of Tokyo Dome City.

The space will also host regular events and collaborative projects, bringing together entertainment companies, Web3 developers, academic institutions, and government partners. These initiatives aim to foster global connections and spark new, "heart-moving" experiences through entertainment.

Location: MEETS PORT 4F, Tokyo Dome City, 1-3-61 Koraku, Bunkyo-ku, Tokyo

Area: 53.91 tsubo (approx. 178 square meters)

Capacity: Up to approximately 40 seats (scheduled)

Membership Fee: Free in principle

Note: The space will generally operate on a free-address basis. Depending on program schedules or project needs, priority seating may be assigned to certain participants.

Note: Operational costs for infrastructure, such as office equipment, may be charged on an annual or monthly basis.

Conditions

Eligible users include companies, organizations, or individuals who meet one or more of the following criteria:

1. Startup Companies

- Operating in business areas related to the assets of Tokyo Dome City, such as sports or entertainment
- Engaged in advanced fields utilizing Web3, XR, AI, or related technologies (e.g., volumetric capture, digital twins)

Companies or teams that are currently working on or planning to work on projects combining the above two areas

2. Organizations or Individuals

Content creators, engineers, or developers whose work aligns with the assets of Tokyo Dome City

3. Partner Companies or Organizations

Entities promoting business development or open innovation through collaboration with startups

Note: There is no limit to the number of members in an organization, but a maximum of three seats may be used at a time.

Note: Nationality is not restricted, but users must be able to communicate in either Japanese or English.

How to Apply

Before general membership opens, usage rights for this space will be awarded to selected participants of the "enXross AWARD 2025", which will be held as part of the "enXross 3rd" open innovation event at Tokyo Dome City on September 29 (Mon), 2025. General membership applications are scheduled to open from October 2025 onward.

The "enXross project" is an initiative aimed at creating projects that utilize cutting-edge technology to pioneer the future of entertainment, as well as supporting and fostering the entrepreneurial spirit of its participants. We've hosted open innovation events twice so far, in December 2023 and July 2024. These events have broadly showcased the appeal of Tokyo Dome City to an international audience and provided opportunities to experience the forefront of Web3 and XR technologies worldwide.

The third edition, "enXross 3rd," is scheduled for September 2025. The main content of this event, the "enXross AWARD 2025," will call for business ideas under the theme of "Technology x Entertainment." Winners of the contest will receive prize money and access to "enXross DAO."




